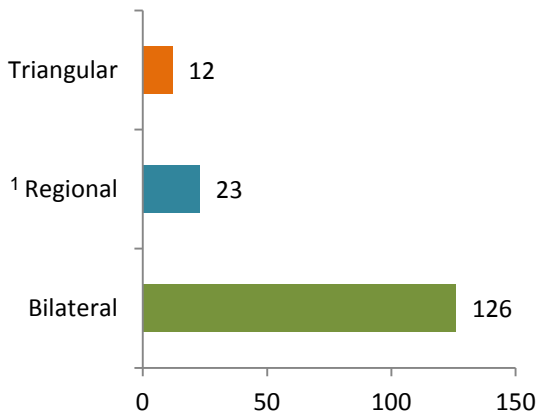

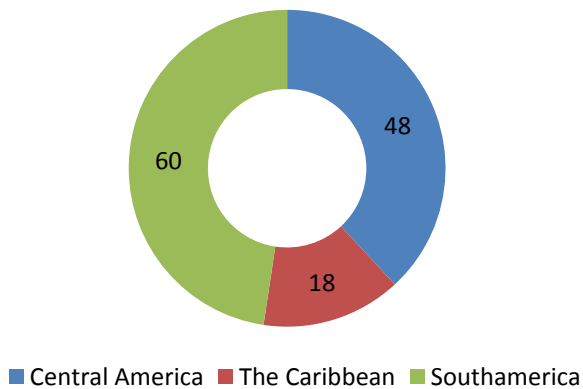


Bilateral cooperation provided by Mexico to Latin America and the Caribbean in 2011

Cooperation Projects by Scheme



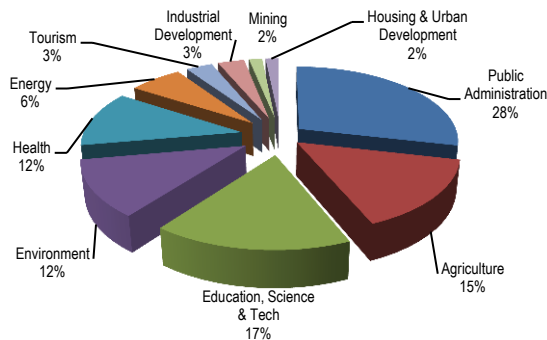
Bilateral Projects by Subregion

- Exchange of information, etc.



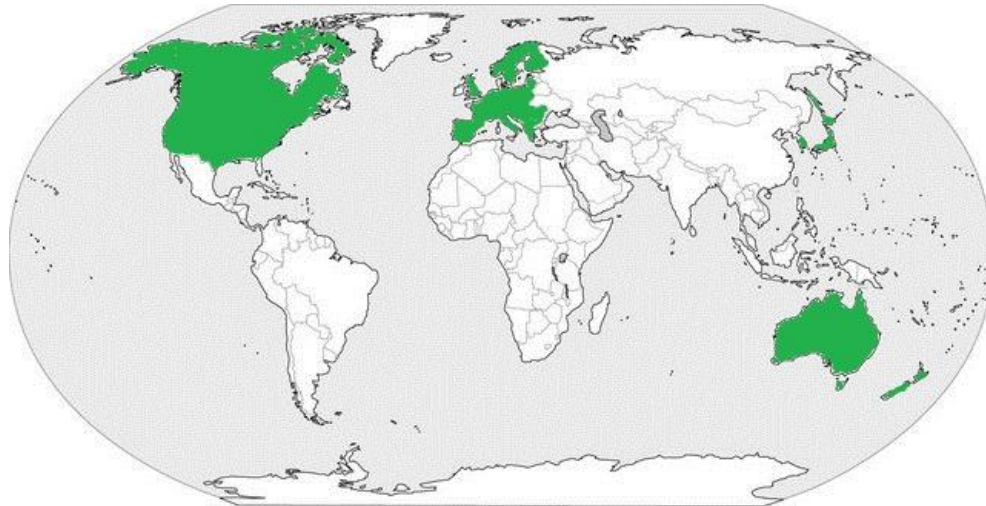
Financial cooperation

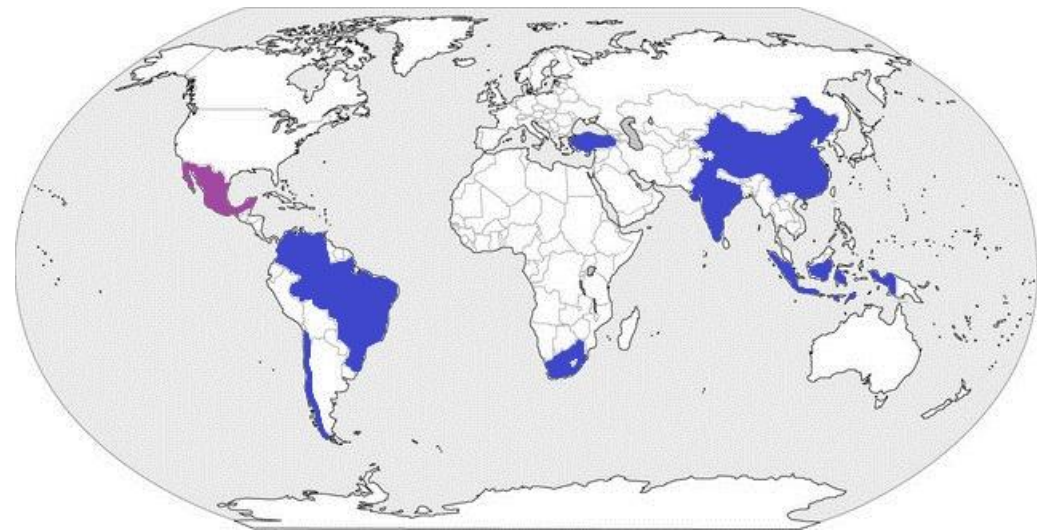

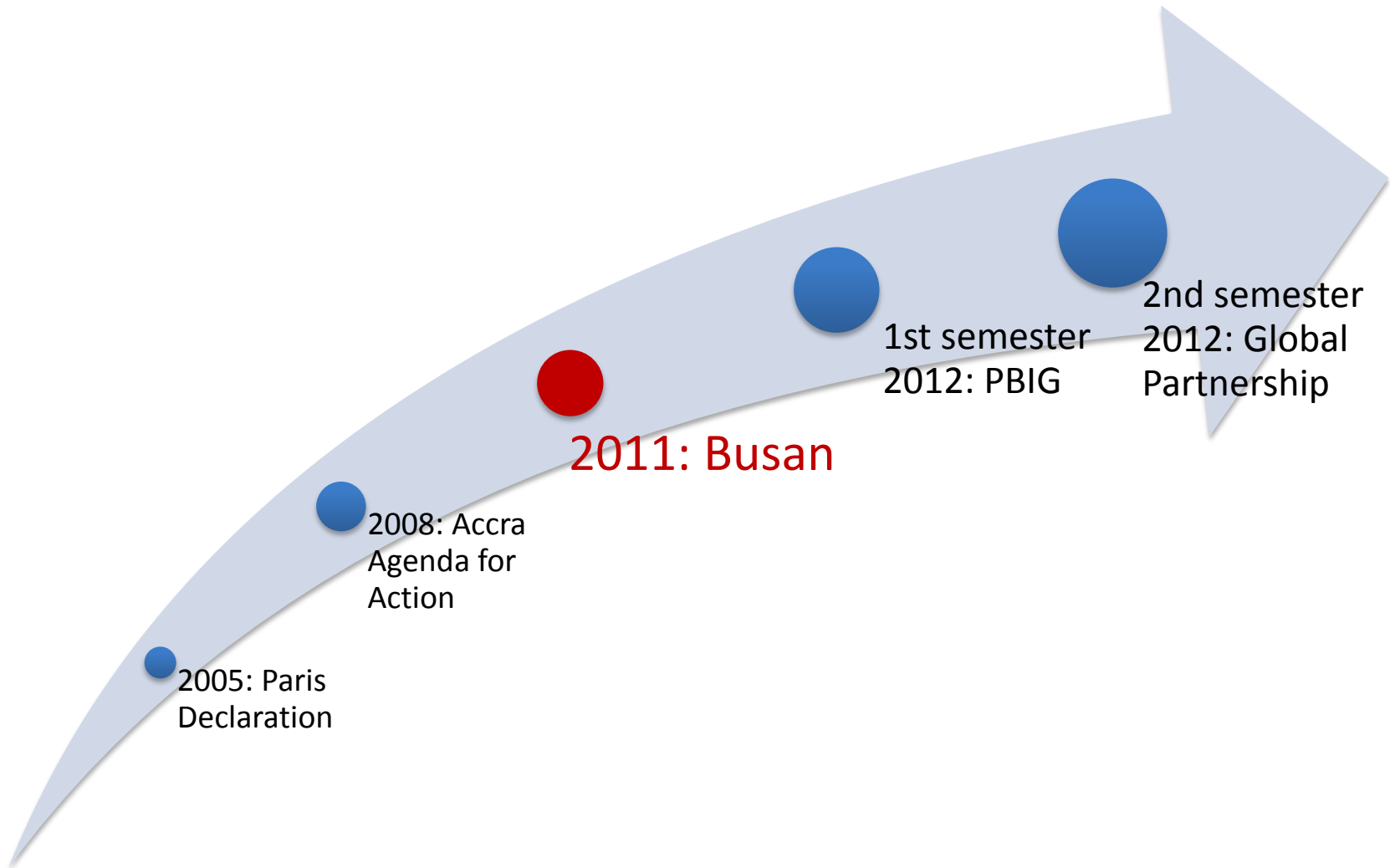
